School Discipline Policy

We have developed a School Discipline Policy which aims to:

1. Provide all children with the skills of living and learning together.
2. To ensure that all children think about their behaviour and have an opportunity to learn in a positive environment.

Our policy outlines our rules, rewards and consequences for appropriate and inappropriate behaviour.

To encourage the children to follow these rules, the teacher will recognise good behaviour with a system of rewards.

If a child chooses to break a rule:	They have a warning
Second time:	They are removed from the group
Third time:	Sent to Head teacher
Fourth time:	Send for parents

If this happens on more than two occasions it is the policy of the Nursery that the child will attend School for one hour per day until his/her behaviour improves. Their time will then gradually to a full day's session.

Rules around the Nursery

1. Listen to and follow instructions
2. Behave in an acceptable manner
3. Be gentle
4. Be kind and helpful
5. Look after all property
6. Be honest
7. Use a quiet voice at all times

Lunchtime Rules

1. To sit at your table quietly
2. Do not leave the table without permission
3. Use a quiet voice
4. To use cutlery appropriately
5. To line up when asked, quietly without any fuss

Playground Rules

1. Listen to instructions
2. Take care of and be respectful to the environment
3. Do not run or push
4. Be kind and gentle
5. Help when asked to put the equipment away
6. Line up quietly

Rewards

1. Individual stars/stamps
2. Visit to Head teacher for praise
3. Assembly certificate
